Introduction

The Story of the Family of Henry Harrison Lindsey

My great-great-grandfather Jacob Lindsey was a free black man from Maryland. He married Mary Coffin of Jamestown NC. The family story is that she was the daughter of Shubal (or of a brother, I haven't found a will to help in verifying this, but my grandfather called Dr. Coffin his grandfather) before he was married to Laura Mendenhall. Dr. Shubal Gardner Coffin started the first medical school in Guilford County, NC with a Dr. Lindsay and Dr. Robbins. He was a member of the famous Coffin family, which started the Underground Railroad and had such notable abolitionists as Levi Coffin and Lucretia Mott. Later notable members of the Coffin family include William Sloan Coffin, Chaplain of Yale University during the Vietnam Era and President Richard Milhouse Nixon. Information I found said that the Friends Society had disavowed Dr. Coffin. The fact that he owned slaves might have been the reason for this. He later was allowed back in. One of his daughters married an arms dealer and information I have recently received might change the way I look at the family stories on him. Since posting my family tree on the Internet I have received these tidbits of information about Shubal Coffin. The first being that Shubal G. Coffin, was connected to, and had dealings in the mining industry in Guilford Co, in the mid to late 1850's. The Guilford Copper and Gold Mining Company were mentioned. Secondly and even more interesting was that, Dr. Shubal Gardner Coffin was a prominent resident of Jamestown, Guilford Co., NC. Two houses that he built are still standing on Main Street. He conducted a medical school in one of them. My wife, who grew up in the area, heard stories that one supposedly had a number of coffins buried in the basement and that the Dr. and his students apparently robbed graves to get dissection specimens. There's also a local story that Dr. Coffin sheltered Jefferson Davis and his cabinet after Richmond fell to the Union army in the spring of 1865. Another legend had it that he was entrusted with the Confederate government's gold and that it was buried somewhere on his grounds. Doubtless a legend, but it's a good story, and more than one small boy has done some digging on the grounds over the years.

If in fact Mary Coffin was white and had children by a free black man, they could not have married; this was illegal in the South. So the family story goes she was listed as a slave on all official records including the census rolls to protect her children from being kidnapped and sold. The slave census of 1850-60 although they are not listed by name the ages and sex confirm that Mary and her children were the only slaves Dr. Coffin had, no male slave old enough to have been the father of the children is listed. My grandfather stated that there was a clause in his will that they could not be sold in the event of his death, but as stated above I have not found the will and Dr. Coffin died well after the Civil War ended so this might have been changed in his will anyway. Mary and Jacob had nine children during this time. Their oldest son William Junius under the surname Coffin ran away and enlisted in the union army during the Civil War. After the war he came back to Jamestown and he and moved his family to Peru, Indiana where the last of their ten children was born. Coincidentally in Peru in the 1870 census Mary is listed as Mulatto and according to Dr. Willard Hess (the author of many books on Quakers and who was the Quaker Historian in Indianapolis, In. at that time), who I spoke to regarding these family stories he said that mixed marriages were also illegal in Indiana then and in order to be listed on the Census as mulatto, you had to look white and there was some possibility that Mary was indeed white. Another coincidence there is another William Junius Coffin buried in Mount Hope Cemetery in Peru and according to a descendant of Dr. Coffin who I spoke with his oldest son William was sent to Indiana to avoid conscription into the Confederate army.

Jacob's son Henry Harrison Lindsey, my great grandfather was born in Jamestown, NC and moved with the family to Peru, IN. As an adult he was of foul temperament and miserly. He was trained as a barber and married an orphan Blackfoot Indian girl, Frances Louise Porter, who had been adopted by Archie and Gertrude Porter in Cairo, IL, where she was born. They were married in 1886 in Evansville, Indiana. They had eight children. The oldest, Polly, was killed when the children were playing at a railroad crossing and a railroad tie fell on her. Because of Henry's bad temper he was always getting into razor fights and the family had to constantly be on the go. Henry did not want to pay full fare on the train so the family would travel with circuses traveling along the Illinois railways. (Six of the children were born along the Illinois Central Railways, Charleston, Mattoon, Carbondale, Galesburg and Peoria, IL.) Now traveling with the circus is not as odd as it would seem. Peru, IN. was the home of the Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus, one of the most famous circuses in the United States, and before the Ringling Brothers became so famous and had winter camp in Saratoga, FL or their home town of Baraboo, Wisconsin, Peru, IL was the winter home of traveling circuses. Family traveled with the circus as Indians. Frances had taught them how to weave baskets and make moccasins. After the birth of their last son, Henry took his family back to the home of his sister, Sarah Lindsey Artis, in Peru, Indiana. According to his sister's granddaughter Helen, her grandmother told her this story. Henry walked out of the front door one day stating that he was going to look for work at the local bagging factory. Sarah asked him wasn't he going the wrong direction, and he stated he knew where he was going, and he was never seen again. There have been many speculations as to what happened to Henry Harrison Lindsey. One story, was that he went to cash in on the free Cherokee land in Oklahoma, another was that he went to Bakersfield, Ca. and remarried. Another was that as had been his usual practice, that this time he had been killed in a razor fight somewhere. There also was the story of the strange man who came to visit Sarah, none of the younger family members recognized him, but the older ones did. He visited a while left and was never seen again. While doing my own research I came across yet another possibility. Shortly after his disappearance the Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus train was involved in a major train disaster. Many people were killed and most were not identified. In fact there were numerous unidentified black men who were killed. The Showmen of America buried the dead from this crash and they are buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, in North Riverside, IL. The areas where the circus performers are buried have elephant markers and numbers and sex listed on tombstones.

Frances left alone with eight children worked as a laundress for Kate Porter, mother of Cole Porter, she fell in love with a married man and had a daughter by him and died in 1911 pregnant with another child.

Harry the oldest son, married Edith Watts and had 7 children the oldest died as a infant in Peru, Indiana and shortly after the next child Harry was born they moved to Chicago, IL. It was there that Harry worked on the railroad as a porter, owned his own upholstery business and had the one of the worst experiences a man can have. In the summer of 1919 Chicago experienced a race riot. Harry was a witness to the murder of Thomas Joshua a black man killed by a white police officer off duty and riding around with his children shooting at black men on the street. The coroner's inquest ruled it self-defense, but all records of the inquest were destroyed on a brief outline exists. After his children had all married he and Edith moved to some property she owned in Cassopolis, Michigan and raised Chickens and vegetables. Edith died in 1960, but Harry lived until he was 95 out living three of his children.

Ben was the next son, all that knew him loved him, but he also had a devilish way about him. He married Elizabeth Perry in Peru, Indiana and they had a son Delany. But after having traveled so much with his parents he too developed wanderlust. He left his family and joined the Circus as a Kid Worker, that's someone who goes into town giving away free tickets. (I had always heard he was in a Wild West Show and when I went to the Ringling Brother's Museum in Baraboo, Wisconsin, they found him in their records with the Main Circus, which was sold the very next year to the Miller Brothers 101 Wild West Show.) After traveling with the Wild West Show he decided to become a cowboy in the movies and made his way to California. I Don't know how much of that he accomplished, he died there, but in old movies I look for someone who looks like my grandfather maybe someday I will see him.

Esther had a very hard life but made the best of every opportunity that came her way. She married at a very young age and had 6 children. Her husband left her and she had to feign for herself. Her brother Ben urged her to come to California, he told her he had a house for her and every thing would be okay. But there was no house, so Esther got her nursing degree and took care of her family and was happy until a tragic accident around Christmas time 1952, killed her and her daughter and her daughter's fiancée.

Junius lead a good life he married Emma Artist and raised four children. He and Emma divorced and he married Rose. In 1973 he became a Jehovah's Witness. According to his obituary he was a man of dreams and had visions, even though he may not have realized all of them he died in 1982.

The last four kids were put into White's Institute and orphanage that had one time been an Indian School founded by Quakers. This affected them all of their lives. None of them understood why the family had abandoned them.

Otha had it bad he was drafted into WWI and was gassed. But he came out of it learning several languages and worked for the US Government for many years. He tried to distance himself from the family; he had brief contact with them. Most of the information I have on him is from official records and a picture he gave his youngest sister, Frances of his two daughters. We don't even know their names. I have always hoped someone would recognize the photo and contact me. That still is my hope.

Ralph also led a hard life. He joined the Merchant Marines and lived all of his Adult life at sea or in New York, far away from his family. It was in New York he met and married Dorothy Reid, but theirs was a short-lived romance for Dorothy died shortly after giving birth to their daughter and Ralph unable to cope with the loss he left her in the care of his mother-in-law and died in 1949.

Ted according to his family, felt abandoned by his brothers and sister and like Otha tried to change who he was by changing the spelling of his surname from Lindsey to Lindsay. But later in life in reflection he said it wasn't a bad place to be there was rich farmland and horses. After leaving there he went to DePauw University in Greencastle, Indiana and graduated. He was active in all aspects of university life and was a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity. He married Nell Watts, niece of Edith Watts, but wasn't prepared for marriage and being a father and they divorced. He came to live in Chicago, met Miss Lucia Bailey and they were married for thirty years until he died in 1973.

Frances the youngest was the child of Francis Porter Lindsey and Milton Jefferson, something she didn't find out until much later in life. In fact she didn't meet her oldest brother Harry until she was an adult. She was raised until the age of eight by her sister Esther, but due to Esther's circumstances he was also sent to White's Institute. One of her first memories of Peru was when she graduated from High School and Kate Porter had a gift for her. Kate told her how fond she was of her mother Frances and how sorry for what she had to go through. Frances then went to the big city Indianapolis became a domestic and nanny and married, but she couldn't stay in one place too long. She divorced her husband then went to Chicago met her brother and worked there again as a domestic and nanny where she married again and divorced again. Then she joined her big brother Ben in California. There she worked for a studio head as a domestic and nanny (I have the letters of recommendations from these employers) and met her final husband and they did like the locals and went to Mexico to marry. They were very happy until his death in 1960. Frances was a lively and friendly woman who lived life to it's fullest. She saved everything and you can read her life in all the letters and cards she kept and she had pictures of everyone except Ben, somehow that got lost. She died in 1990.

That's just some of the people from my branch of the Lindsey family; I encourage other family members of Jacob and Mary's family to add their stories too.

First Medical School in North Carolina was operated in Jamestown, ca 1820-1830 by Dr. Madison Lindsay in a house now owned by the Historic Jamestown Society

Second medical school opened in 1840 by Dr. Shubal Coffin in an important Greek Revival house (restored), later occupied by Dr. J. L. Robbins, among the first to use ether in the state.

Mention of Dr. Coffin in Biography of Dr. Madison Lindsay

DR. MADISON LINDSAY, He was I.J.M. Lindsay, whose full given name was Isaac James Madison. He was born 19 March 1804, and died Nov. 1854. He was the son of Samuel Lindsay and Hetty E. Causey Lindsay, who lived in the Stinking Quarter area of Guilford Co.

Madison Lindsay probably established his "college" in Jamestown soon after he reached his majority in 1825. And he was elsewhere by 1830, when the federal census shows him as "Dr. J.J. Lindsey", a householder, living alone, and not in Jamestown.

Two of his known medical trainees, Shubal G. Coffin and John Milton Worth, were enrolled in the Transylvania University Medical Department, in Lexington, Ky., in 1831-2, to complete their studies. However, there is no record of Joseph A. Weatherly and George D. Mendenhall, two of Lindsay's other known students.

Details of Lindsay's own medical education are also unknown. It may have begun with a kind of apprenticeship with a family member or other mentor, as was then common. In Madison's case, it could have started with another uncle, Dr. Joseph Wood. His formal training did not take place at Transylvania, according to its records, but several American colleges and universities had established medical departments by the time Lindsay would have been attending.

On 18 April 1832 Madison married Jane E. Dick, a daughter of Thomas and Jane Erwin Dick. By 1833, Lindsay had established his "practice of Physic, Surgery and Midwifery" in Greensboro, as his advertisement stated. Dr. Lindsay continued until his death to practice medicine in Greensboro, and served for some years as the town's postmaster.

Jane, who was born 2 May 1810, died 17 May 1848. Following Madison's death on 6 Nov. 1854, his death notice in the Greensboro Patriot says that he left an orphaned daughter. Madison's and Jane's graves are in Green Hill Cemetery in Greensboro.

June Lindsey of North Dukes Street died Saturday morning and the funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon. Conducted in the A.M.E. church on East Third street. Mr. Lindsey was one of the pioneer colored men of this locality and had many friends. He served in the Civil War and members of the Grand Army attended the funeral. The minister officiating was Rev. Marshall Gaines of Kokomo and the Colored Mason of Wabash, with whom Mr. Lindsey was affiliated, conducted services at the grave in Mount Hope Cemetery.

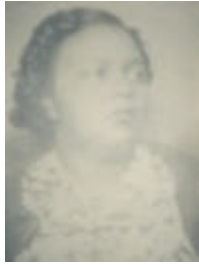

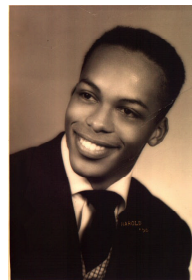

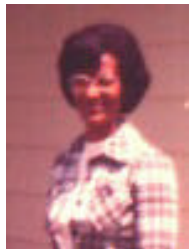
